Mr. Dan Kuhar was appointed as the School Director for Odyssey's Junior/Senior High School. Mr. Kuhar will begin as the School's new leader on July 1st.

A native of Florida and graduate of Charlotte High School in Punta Gorda, Mr. Kuhar received his Bachelor's of Science in Zoology and his Master's in Science Education, both from the University of Florida. Mr. Kuhar most recently served as Director of Kihei Charter School in Hawaii. He spent ten years in curriculum design and school leadership positions where he was responsible for building one of Hawaii's most respected charter schools. Dan worked with his local school board,

community partners, and a great staff to create innovative learning environments with a custom designed educational program.

SUMMER REGISTRATION ~ JULY 15-18

Annual registration is mandatory for all new and returning students. Registration will secure your child's seat at Odyssey. **This year students must register at the campus they are attending.**

If you attended Registration during the week of June 3-7, you are NOT required to attend! If you would like to see who your child's teachers will be, class assignments will be posted on campus and can be viewed any time on/after August 5.

Registration days and times are:

Lower Elementary Campus:

- Day Registration: Monday July 15, 9 am -1pm
- Evening Registration, Wednesday, July 17, 5-7:30 pm

Upper Junior/Senior High Campus:

- Day Registration: Tuesday, July 16, 9-1 pm
- Evening Registration: Thursday, July 18, 5-7:30 pm

Required Documents and Student Fees for Registration:

ALL OCS students must have the following documents on file before the first day of school. The student categories listed in parentheses are required to update/submit current documents for this school year.

- Birth certificate (K and new students)
- Current Immunization form (K, 7, 9, new students)
- Current Physical Exam (K, 7, 9, new students)
- Parents – please remember your ID
- All IEPs, EPs, Behavioral Plans, or 504 Plans (All new students to Odyssey)
- Student Fees – check or money orders ONLY! (Made payable to Odyssey Charter School)
- K-5th - \$7 (technology fee, nutrition education & Spalding notebook fee)
- 6th-9th - \$8 (technology and science lab fee)

STUDENT PLANNERS

Good news OCS families! This year, we were able to get enough donations from some of our community partners to sponsor planners for the 3rd-9th grade students. That means the first planner issued to your student will be issued free of cost.

Any lost planners must be replaced and will be available for a fee of \$5. Check out the ads on your student's planner when they arrive and be sure to support the community partners who made it possible to issue your children a planner free of charge.

BUS TRANSPORTATION

Free bus transportation will be provided to children who live within 2-4 miles and further from the school, based upon student population needs. A bus slip must be completed for families who wish to sign up for bus service. Bus slips will be available at registration. For those families who applied for bus service during early registration week, a member of bus services will call you to finalize your registration. Students who live less than two miles from the school are not eligible for bus transportation.

****Student bus slips must be given to the driver on the first day you use the bus service. Parents who registered early and who qualify for bus service will receive a phone call from our transportation staff with their student's bus stop location and times. After receiving your bus stop, parents should pick up a bus slip (required for the first bus ride) from the front office of your student's campus, during regular office hours and before the first day of school.*

SCHOOL UNIFORMS & CHANGES FOR THE 2013-2014 SCHOOL YEAR

All Odyssey Students are required to wear a school uniform. Our uniforms can be purchased through our NEW uniform provider, All Uniform Wear (321-608-3845) or online at www.alluniformwear.com. They are located at 2585 W. New Haven Ave (Rte. 192), West Melbourne, 32904, across from the Melbourne Square Mall. There have been some uniform changes, that we announced in May's OCS newsletter. We have printed them below again for your convenience.

Parents with students at our Lower Campus: Please note as we transition into our new uniform company, students may continue to wear the T-shirts and polos with the old uniform logo for the 2013-2014 year only.

Both Lower and Upper Campuses:

- Students will need to wear either a black or brown belt.
- Students will need to have shirts tucked in.
- Only OCS sweatshirts or jackets will be worn while in school.
- All shoes must have backs or straps. Students may not wear open-back shoes.

Lower Campus:

- Students will wear the same uniform with new logo
- Students will wear dark green or white polo's or tee shirts with proper logo
- Students may wear khaki shorts, skirts, skorts or pants.

Upper Campus Only:

- Students will wear grey, light blue, royal blue, or white polo's and t-shirts with the proper logo.
- Students may wear either khaki or black shorts, skirts, and pants.
- Students may transfer over only the white polo or tee shirt from Lower Campus.

(The green polo and tee shirt will remain for Lower Campus students only and may be donated to the front desk at Odyssey's lower campus.)

MONTESSORI VPK & PRESCHOOL

Limited openings are still available in our Montessori preschool and VPK. If you have a child joining the program during the 2013-2014 school year and missed May's Orientation, just stop by the front office at the Lower Campus to pick up the parent information and registration packet.

Please know that In order to fully register your child, we will also need the following items before the first day of school: a copy of your child's birth certificate, your child's immunization form, your child's physical form, the VPK voucher for the 2013-14 school year and a copy of your child's Individual Education Plan (IEP).

The Odyssey Preparatory program on Wyoming Drive will also feature a VPK/ preschool. 
